## Coming by Car?

### Here's some things you should know:

- Arriving campers be at the landing after 1:30 pm on Sunday
  - Pick up departing campers at 9:30 a.m. on Sunday
- Directions to Camp Tuk:**
- From Parks Hwy, turn onto Big Lake Road
  - Bear left onto S Big Lake Rd
  - Cont. past South Port Marina to stop sign
  - Turn right onto Sunitna Pkwy
  - At end of pavement, turn right onto Purinton Way
  - Proceed approx. one mile
  - Turn right on at sign that points to "Mud Lake-Flat Lake"
  - Go past "Call of the Wild" sign
  - Continue straight ahead and follow curve to the left
  - Follow dirt track road (it's VERY narrow for approx 1/2 mile
  - As you enter the parking lot, the landing is on your left
