WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Accommodations: An outdoor rain fly will be set up for a covered gathering area. Bring your own tent and rain fly—tenting is a necessity!

Activities: Gold planning, hiking, target shooting, rafting, and photography.

Age Limit: There are no age restrictions for the 2024 retreat.

Clothing: Come prepared for cool nights and rain; one never knows.

Meals: Bring your own backpacking food, cooking gear, stove and cookware.

Musical Instruments: Share your talents—the more the merrier!

Pets: Please leave them at home. This is not the venue to bring pets.

Transportation: Logistics require that unless you have your own transportation, you must attend all days of the retreat. Transportation options include:

- Hiking: 13 miles one-way on a four-wheeler trail (shorter and rougher than the trail below).
